Details Itinerary:

Day 01: Arrive in Kathmandu Nepal,

Day 02: Guided sightseeing Tour

Kathmandu Durbar Square:

Kasthamandap, the source of the name Kathmandu means 'made from the timber of a single tree'. Also known as Kantipur, the capital Kathmandu is the hub of Nepal's art and culture. It is a place for rest, relaxation and easy-day sightseeing of historic and artistic temples and monuments. Kathmandu Durbar Square with its arrays of temples, Kumari Temple, Seto Machhindranath and the ancient palace of the former Nepali Royals enriches your experience of the century's old civilization.





Swayambhunath: You'll get a scenic view of Kathmandu city from there. Said to be around 2000 years old, this Buddhist Stupa sits atop a hill. The main stupa is composed of a solid hemisphere of brick and earth supporting a lofty conical spire crowned by a pinnacle of Copper gilt. Swoyambhu is also Painted on the four sided base of the spire are the all-seeing eyes of Lord Buddha. It is also known as Samhengu and the Monkey temple because of the countless monkeys living in the premises

Patan Durbar Square:

The word patan means "city of fine arts" is extremely famous for exceptional ancient craftwork. It has hundreds of fascinating Hindu and Buddhist monuments scattered in and around. Patan is probably one of the oldest Buddhist cities in the world. The Patan Durbar Square has been described as picturesque collection of buildings that have been set up small a place by the piety of oriental man.

One remarkable monument here is 16th century temple dedicated to the Hindu god Krishna, built entirely of stone.

Day 03: Guided Sightseeing tour

After breakfast commence the sightseeing tour of Bauddhanath, Pashupatinath and Bhaktapur

Option 1 – AM; Mountain Flight: One of the must-see landmarks of Nepal is, of course, the highest peak in the world – Mount Everest. An awe-stricken silence comes close to matching the experience of a mountain flight. For one hour, you'll fly over the Eastern Himalayan Ranges of Nepal where some of the highest peaks in the world including Mt. Everest lie for a surreal feeling as you come face to face with the world's tallest and most enigmatic of Mountains. Even those visitors who like the rigors of a trek won't miss the opportunity to "conquer" the mountains in one stunning swoop.

Bhaktapur Durbar square:

Bhaktapur is a unique old town and third largest city of kathmandu valley. It is also said to have been built in the shape of conch shell a sacred symbol of Lord Vishnu. The word Bhaktapur means the "city of devotees" and is renowned for its elegant are, culture and colorful festivals. Before the unification of Nepal, It was independent principality ruled by the Malla Kings, who were devoted to religion, culture & art. During the period many magnificent temples and mansions ware built. That period is remembered as golden period in the Nepalese are and remains a unique example.

It is also considered as an open museum of medieval art and architecture with fine examples of sculptures, wood carving and pagoda temples dedicated to many gods and goddesses. The ancient traditions of locals, festivals, colorful celebrations, excellent architectures are the living proofs of its rich cultural heritage in Nepal.

Pashupatinath Temple: Pashupatinath Temple is one of the oldest Hindu Temples dedicated to Lord Shiva. It is for the Hindus what Mecca is for the Muslims. Situated amidst a lush green natural setting on the bank of the sacred Bagmati River, the temple built in Pagoda Style with gilded roof and richly carved silver doors. Pashupatinath is the centre of annual pilgrimage on the day of Shivaratri which falls in the month of February/March. You'll also be able to see cremation grounds that lie on the bank of Bagmati behind the temple.

Boudhanath Stupa: One of the oldest and the biggest Buddhist monuments ever built in Nepal. Boudhanath is one of the holiest structures imposing a height of 36 meters with three massive level Mandala style platforms. It is surrounded by colorful buildings housing families creating a friendly enclosure. The Stupa is visited every year by tens of thousands of pilgrims from all over the world.

Day 04: Departure Transfer
